The Mackinac Island trip has always been a non-electronic event. We do not allow **cell phones**, Ipods, tablets etc. This has always, initially, caused some consternation with the students. However, it has been our experience that the students become much more engaged with their surroundings, friends and the magic that is Mackinac. All of the teachers will have smart-phones available to take pictures, text highlights to school, and for parents to check in **IF NEED BE**. I will create a Google folder to be shared with all students and parents for pictures. If your student feels he or she must have a phone for pictures it will be with his or her teacher and given out for pictures only. These are the same rules we have at school. In this selfie obsessed / social media world we live in today, this may be the last time for some of these students to truly unplug!
